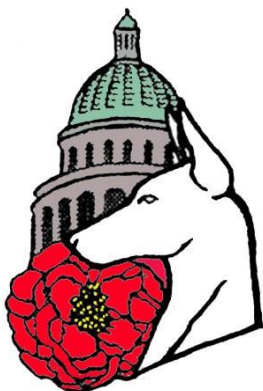

*A neutered male may be entered in Veteran Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered in Veteran Bitch Class. Winners of these classes may compete for Best of Breed if otherwise undefeated but are not required to.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs that according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owner's records. Select Dog and/or Select Bitch, if applicable, will be chosen immediately following Best of Breed.

JUDGES AWARD OF MERIT

The judge may select up to 10% of the superior quality specimens in addition to Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex from the Inter-sex Competition to receive an Award of Merit.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES (SUNDAY AM Show ONLY)

Stud Dog Class: Each entry consists of a Stud dog and at least two, but not more than three, of his get (being either dog, bitch or a combination). The award will be based on the merits of the get. The owner of the Stud Dog does not need to be the owner of the get. All get must be entered in a regular class at the Sunday AM show. If Stud Dog is entered in Sunday AM show, Stud Dog class is considered an additional class (\$20). If not entered Sunday AM, it is considered First Entry (\$30).

Brood Bitch Class: Same as Stud Dog, just substitute "Brood Bitch" for "Stud Dog" and "produce" for "get."

*A neutered male may be entered in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed Bitch may be entered in the Brood Bitch Class.

FOUR-TO-SIX MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION (Saturday AM ONLY)

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for Doberman Pinschers that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin. All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol. Professional handlers, members of their household, and current assistants are not allowed to handle dogs in this competition. Entry Fee: \$15.00. Entries are to be made on an official AKC Entry Form.

Tagalongs must fit within your assigned space or park in a regular parking space. No cords across any sidewalks, walkways, roadways, or fire lanes, or in any type of building (not designated). Violators will be disconnected immediately.

1. Entries must reach the Show Secretary, DogZibit, P. O. Box 2044, Woodinville, WA 98072-2044 by the closing date & time specified in the Premium List. After which time no entries can be accepted, canceled, changed, substituted, corrected, completed or signed and no entry fees refunded. Any change or cancellation must be made in writing and received prior to closing, except as provided in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the American Kennel Club Dog Show Rules and Regulations. Fees must accompany entries; DogZibit assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. The Club and/or DogZibit assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner.
2. No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, FAX email, phone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are **not acceptable**. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with this agreement. Rule books may be obtained from the AKC, 5580 Centerview Dr., Raleigh, NC 27606. The Club and/or DogZibit assumes no responsibility for incorrect or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent which includes entering a dog in a class which the dog is not eligible to compete. **Responsibility for completeness of entry rests solely with entrant. Note: When you enter online, you agree to the same terms found on the official AKC Entry form found in the Premium.**
3. **Returned checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. DogZibit will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
4. **Exhibitors' entry acknowledgements** will be made as soon as practicable by email to the address given on the entry blank. If not received by the end of the closing date, notify DogZibit. Judging programs will be sent at least a week prior to the show.
5. **Refunds** for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be processed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will apply. Entry fees will not be refunded when a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for duplicate entries.
6. **Refunds for show cancellation:** DPCS is closely monitoring the health and safety concerns of the state regarding Covid-19. We are following the CDPH guidelines and AKC best practices with the health and welfare of our exhibitors, judges, members and all attendees in mind. If the venue is required to close because of Covid-19 prior to September 25, 2020 and the show is cancelled, DPCS will refund RV reservation, CGC pre-registration and Cardio pre-registration fees (less any credit card processing fees if applicable). Entry fees will be refunded minus a \$5.00 fee to cover administration and processing. This same policy applies to extreme weather, local/state/national emergency or event which is natural, or man-made that is outside the control of the club and considered not safe for the dogs, exhibitors or spectators.
