If a debit or credit card was used for payment, we cannot refund the credit card handling fees.** If we are able to hold the shows, outlined safety requirements will be included with the judging program, and will be based on the AKC Best Practices (available at akc.org), the Oregon State suggested practices, and suggestions from the CDC.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS – ALL EVENTS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this Show and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium List.

- The American Kennel Club will collect: a \$3.00 Event Service Fee and \$.50 Recording Fee where applicable for the first entry of a dog, plus a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and nonregular recordable single-entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. At every licensed or member club rally trial, a recording fee of \$3.50 is required for the first entry of each dog and a recording fee of \$3.00 is required for each additional entry of the same dog.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, FAX, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or DogZibit assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. **RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.**
- **RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE.** DogZibit will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- **REFUNDS** for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent **AFTER THE SHOW.** An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries. *Fee waived if cancellation due to COVID-19 concerns.*
- **FEMALES IN SEASON** are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Show Secretary is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Club is required to refund the entry fee. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will apply. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address show entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify DogZibit at 425-765-9146 or email Entries@DogZibit.com. Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for **DUPLICATE ENTRIES** or **OVERPAYMENTS.** NO REFUND will be made if, because of riots, civil disturbances, other acts beyond the control of the management, or anything that impacts the well-being of the dogs, exhibitors, and spectators (which is of paramount importance) where it is impossible to open or complete the show. To find out about any AKC event cancellations, call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.
- Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 11, Section 15 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
- **LOSS OR DAMAGE** – The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these Shows. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs that according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owner's records. Select Dog and/or Select Bitch, if applicable, will be chosen immediately following Best of Breed.

JUDGES AWARD OF MERIT

The judge may select up to 10% of the superior quality specimens in addition to Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex from the Inter-sex Competition to receive an Award of Merit.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (Involving single dog entries) – BOTH SPECIALTIES

*VETERAN DOG *VETERAN BITCH

**HUNTING RETRIEVER DOG **HUNTING RETRIEVER BITCH

*Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a neutered male may be entered as a Veteran Dog in the Veteran Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Veteran Bitch in the Veteran Bitch Class."

Hunting Dog and Hunting Bitch Classes are for those Labradors who have received a Junior, Senior and/or Master Hunting Title in an AKC licensed or member Trial. **Entrants must be intact.

Winners of the above classes, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (involving multiple dog entries)– BOTH SPECIALTIES

Note: Non-regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.

STUD DOG CLASS AND BROOD BITCH CLASS: Each entry is allowed two get. The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. *All get must be entered in a regular class in order to be eligible to compete in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class.* Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited, must wear armbands. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION – FRIDAY ONLY

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED:

- **Junior**-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show
- **Intermediate**-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show
- **Senior**-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

SWEEPSTAKES – BOTH EVENTS

To encourage the showing of promising Labrador Retrievers between the ages of six months and eighteen months, a Sweepstakes will be held in conjunction with the RCLRC's Specialty Shows. The age of a dog shall be calculated up to and inclusive of the first day of the show. *Dogs entered in these classes must also be entered in a Regular Class. Professional Handlers may handle only their own dogs.* The specific Sweepstakes class must be given on entry blank in space marked "Additional Class".

BE AWARE THAT CAMPING SITES HAVE AN AM CHECK OUT TIME.

Plan to bring chairs and shade protection for you and your dog. In July this site can become very warm and care must be taken to see that dogs are not left in vehicles to become overheated.

Show Site within the Park: Please note the new show site is the RIVERSIDE AREA. At the first kiosk turn left and follow the road to the large parking area. The show site is located just down the path. Please bring plenty of crates or x-pens for your dogs. There will be more shade ringside but none in the parking lot for vehicles.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION AND RULES

AS SPECIFIED IN CHAPTER 12, SECTION 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the Club’s show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

THE ROSE CITY LABRADOR RETRIEVER CLUB reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging is over and the Show Secretary advised at once. The Show Secretary and the Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the class is over.

EXERCISE DOGS in designated areas only. Handlers are expected to clean up promptly after their dogs at all motel sites and events.

AKC RULES STATE THAT ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under the American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show precincts. AT NO TIME WILL PUPPIES under the age of 6 months be allowed within the show Precincts.

THERE SHALL BE NO drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

NO PRACTICING IN RINGS. DOGS ALLOWED in rings during judging only.

ALL REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE USE OF THE STATE PARK and all regulations and decisions of the Event Committee will be strictly enforced, including any not recorded in this Premium List.

DOGS FOUND IN AN UNSAFE environment, distress or harm’s way (for example left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip) will be removed to safety by Club officials or security personnel. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm’s way will be investigated by the Event Committee.

PEE WEE COMPETITION

(Geared for children ages 5-9). The competition will be held AFTER Winners Dogs on Friday

An AKC Judge will mentor the participants. Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, their responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a FUN learning experience for the child and the adult.

- ✓ Entry Fee has been waived by the club. There is NO COST for this event. Entries will be accepted on the day of the event
- ✓ A dog must be at least 4 months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- ✓ All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- ✓ A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside the ring.
- ✓ Dogs that are allowed: Labrador Retriever only
- ✓ A release must be signed by the child’s parent or legal guardian. Pee Wee Release of Liability will be available at the show. A time and ring will be listed in the judging program.
- ✓ The safety of the dog and child inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. At the Judge’s discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes, the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both the child and adult will walk the dog together.

Although the word “judge” will be used, this is designed to be a learning and mentoring experience – the Junior will be not be “judged” but rather will be mentored with the age appropriate amount of information to help prepare them for what they will be expected to know about AKC regular Junior Showmanship once they reach 9 years of age. The children will be mentored one child, their adult, and dog in the ring at a time. Each child will receive a participation ribbon or rosette, and a gift, to commemorate the experience.

There is no pre-entry, but we would like to know the number of Pee Wee Participants to expect. 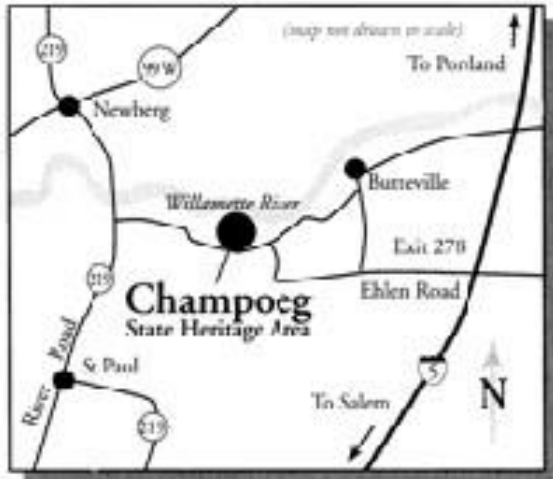

- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as AKC Canine Partners Listed Dog "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
