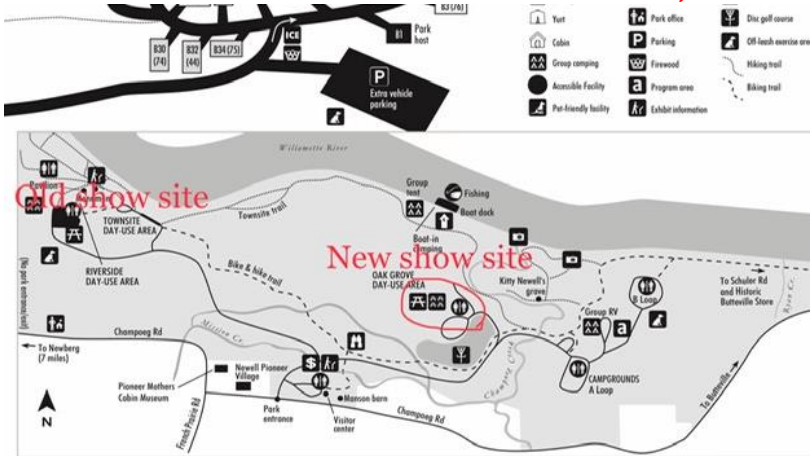

At this time, **MASKS ARE OPTIONAL** at the RCLRC Specialty in accordance with the guidance issued by the State of Oregon at the end of June.

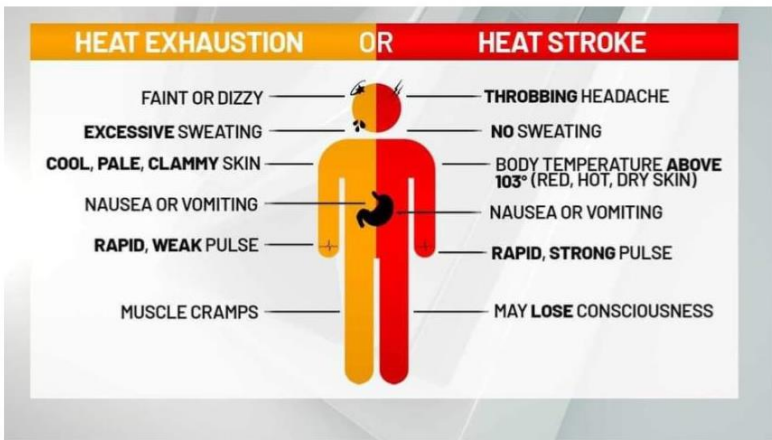
- The Oregon Health Authority strongly recommends those unvaccinated or who are at risk for severe COVID-19 disease to continue to wear a mask.

Champoeg State Heritage Area is located ~30 miles southwest of Portland off Interstate 5.

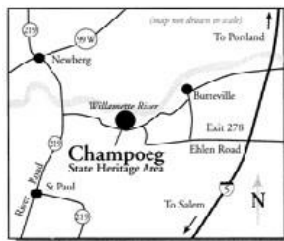
From Interstate 5, take Exit 278 – Donald/Aurora Exit. Follow signs to the Park.

From the I-5 exit you will go west on Ehlen Road.

Go approximately 2.6 miles and take a slight right onto Yergen Road. Continue on Yergen Rd NE, 1.0 mi. Turn right at Case Rd NE, 1.3 mi. Slight left at Champoeg Rd NE, 0.9 mi.

Park entrance will be on right.

Note: \$5 per day parking fee charged at the gate.



IMPORTANT PARKING NOTICE

Rose City Labrador Club reserves the right to hold parking space for judges, event committee chairperson and other event personnel. Out of respect for other attendees there is no reserving or coning off parking space. Parking is a first-come first-serve basis.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS AND SPECTATORS – IMPORTANT SITE INFORMATION

Show Site Entrance Fee: Champoeg State Park charges a day use fee of \$5.00 per vehicle per day at the park. Display your receipt on your front dashboard.

Overnight Camping: Overnight parking with RV hook-ups is available in another part of Champoeg State Park. Call Oregon State Reservations Northwest at 1-800-452-5687 for information and reservations. The Park also has 6 Cabins and “Yurts” (a Mongolian tent) which sleep 5 for rent in this area, no dogs are allowed in the Yurts, they must be kenneled outside. As this is a State Park, we suggest for RV, cabin and Yurt reservations be made as soon as possible. Website: www.oregonstateparks.org. **BE AWARE THAT CAMPING SITES HAVE AN AM CHECK OUT TIME.**

Plan to bring chairs and shade protection for you and your dog. In July this site can become very warm and care must be taken to see that dogs are not left in vehicles to become overheated.

Show Site within the Park: Please note the new show site is the OAK GROVE AREA. At the first kiosk go straight, then at the stop sign turn left. The show site is located by the restrooms. Please bring plenty of crates or x-pens for your dogs. There will be more shade ringside but none in the parking lot for vehicles.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION AND RULES

THE ROSE CITY LABRADOR RETRIEVER CLUB reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging is over and the Show Secretary advised at once. The Show Secretary and the Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the class is over.

EXERCISE DOGS in designated areas only. Handlers are expected to clean up promptly after their dogs at all motel sites and events.

AKC RULES STATE THAT ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under the American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show precincts. AT NO TIME WILL PUPPIES under the age of 6 months be allowed within the show Precincts.

THERE SHALL BE NO drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

NO PRACTICING IN RINGS. DOGS ALLOWED in rings during judging only.

ALL REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE USE OF THE STATE PARK and all regulations and decisions of the Event Committee will be strictly enforced, including any not recorded in this Premium List.

DOGS FOUND IN AN UNSAFE environment, distress or harm's way (for example left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip) will be removed to safety by Club officials or security personnel. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way will be investigated by the Event Committee.

TRANSFER OF ENTRIES

NOTE: TRANSFER OF ENTRIES AND REQUESTS FOR REFUNDS FOR PUBLISHED JUDGE CHANGES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN THE OFFICE AFTER 12:00 NOON ON TUESDAY, JULY 13. AFTER THIS TIME, YOU MUST CONTACT THE SHOW SECRETARY ON SITE.

CONFORMATION: Dogs may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is presented to the Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP: Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show. Correction may be made from one age division to another, provided this transfer must be made to the Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship class at the show.

OBEDIENCE OR RALLY: A transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class; or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner's records the handler and dog are eligible provided the club offers transfers. Transfers from an "A" to "B" class at the same level are allowed provided the host club allows transfers. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the Show Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available, and the class has not reached its limit.

REFUND FOR BITCHES IN SEASON IN OBEDIENCE OR RALLY: Bitches in season are not allowed to compete in Obedience and/or Rally trials. If a bitch comes into season after entries close, the Club will refund the entry fee for both Obedience and/or Rally entries, providing the Show Secretary is notified in writing of the withdrawal at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start of the show/trials. The club will issue and mail the refund check to the listed owner of the bitch.
